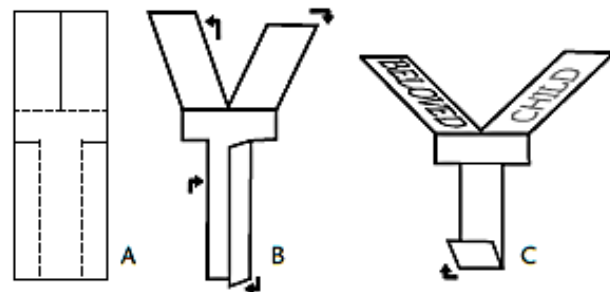

Fluttering Dove

YOU WILL NEED
8½" x 11" piece of paper
ruler
pencil, marker
scissors



Directions:

- Cut the sheet of paper in half vertically so you have two sheets that are 4¼" x 11".
- Use a ruler and pencil to draw the pattern you see in Diagram A: Draw the horizontal dotted line 5" from the top. Leave 1" between this horizontal dotted line and the two short solid lines beneath it.
- Cut along the solid lines and fold along the dotted lines (Diagram B).
- Print BELOVED on one of the "wings" and CHILD on the other as a reminder of God's gift of the Spirit to you.
- Fold up a small square at the bottom (Diagram C).
- Drop your fluttering dove while standing on a chair, from the top landing of a staircase, or from an open window (with permission!).
- Make another fluttering dove. Experiment with altering the measurements. How do these changes affect its fluttering?
