### Directions

*Before the session*, make a list of six places in your church where one can observe people serving and caring for one another. Create clues to direct the children to each place (see examples below).

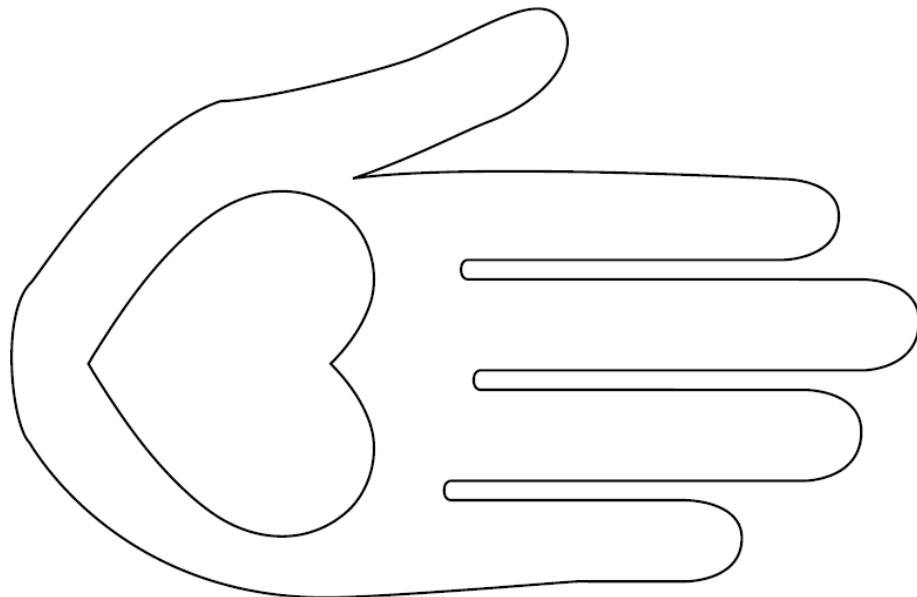
Example clues:

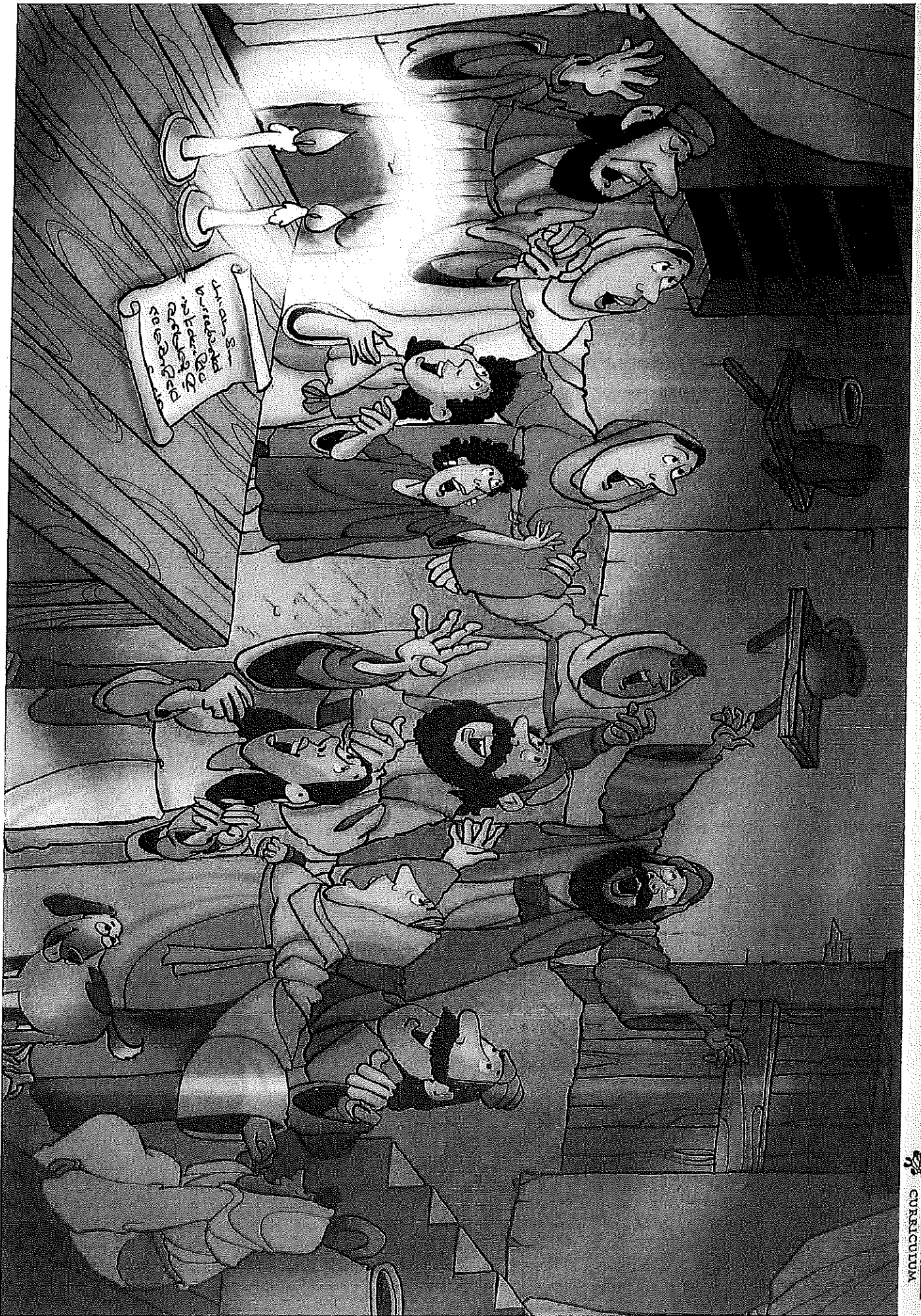
- Where are babies looked after with love and care?
- Where do people place their donations for the food pantry?
- Where do people prepare food and drinks for others?
- Where do people print the bulletin and help prepare for the worship service?
- Where can you find information about projects that help others?
- Where does the minister talk to people when they need help?
- Where do people go to pray for others?

Make six copies of the handprint below and one copy of the clues you've written for every team of three or four learners.

During the activity, form pairs or teams of three. Give each team one copy of the prepared list of clues and six handprints. Ask them to read through the list and discuss the clues. When they are ready, they should go to each place and leave a paper handprint there. Circulate in the area where teams are at work to answer their questions.
