

## ALWAYS SAFE

### Psalm 18:2

God always wants you to be safe. Your parents do too. They do everything they can to take care of you. They dress you in warm clothes when it's cold outside, and hold your hand when cross the street. If your parents have to go somewhere and can't bring you, they ask someone they trust to stay with you. You can trust both your parents and God to keep you safe.

*Remember:* My parents and my God make three and together they take good care of me!

### CRAFT – Whooo takes care of me?

#### Materials

- Empty toilet paper roll
- Construction paper or fabric
- Glue and tape if needed
- Large Googly eyes, if you have them
- Scissors with adult supervision/ assistance

#### ***Start with your empty toilet paper roll.***

- On one end (now the top) press one side then the opposite side in until they meet in the middle creating 'ears.'
- Tape the two sides meeting in the center.

#### ***Now cover the body with paper or fabric feathers.***

- Glue the feathers in place.
- Cut 2 larger curved tear drop shapes and glue 1 to each side for the wings.
- Cut a triangle out for the beak.
- Cut two large circles out for the eyes. Attach googly eyes if you have them.
- Glue beak and eyes on to the top third of the toilet paper roll owl.
- Add your own finishing touches and think about everyone who loves & takes care of you.
