Scripture Reference: Isaiah 12

Story

As it gets colder, find new comfy places to snuggle and share stories.

We have a very special holiday coming up this week. Can you tell me what it is? That's right – it's Thanksgiving! Thanksgiving is a special time when we can think about all the things God gives us that we can be thankful for.

But the bible tells us that we need to thank God all the time, not just on Thanksgiving Day. There is a book in the Old Testament part of the bible called "Isaiah." Isaiah was a prophet. A prophet is someone who listens to God and tells the people things that God wants them to know.

One thing that Isaiah told the people was that they should thank God all the time and they should tell everyone about all the wonderful things God does. God wanted those people to remember to be thankful. And God wants us to be thankful, too! Can you think of some things you want to thank God for?
